

## 2018 PICK UP DATES

The Department of Public Works will begin picking up yard waste each Monday of the month beginning April 2, 2018.

The Department of Public Works will begin picking up brush the first Monday of each month, beginning April 2, 2018.

Yard waste and brush pickup will continue through November 2018.

Yard waste and brush should be placed along the road no earlier than the Friday before the scheduled pickup begins. All yard waste and brush must be beside the road by 7:00 a.m. on Monday. Brush and yard waste must be in separate piles.

## Brush and Yard Waste

This year we will again provide a brush and yard waste drop off site. Residents are able to bring brush and bagged (paper bags only) yard waste to the Village Hall (47 Cole Street) during normal business hours, Monday - Thursday, 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

## 2018 Guide To Brush & Yard Waste

## Brush & Yard Waste Policy

In an effort to improve the appearance of the Village and as a service to its citizens, the Quincy Department of Public Works will provide roadside brush, yard waste, and bulk leaf pick up. Village residents are asked to follow the policy as outlined inside this brochure to allow the Quincy Department of Public Works to provide the highest level of service possible.

### Spring Clean Up

Spring yard waste clean up is April 9 – April 19. During this period, residents are able to place leaves and other yard waste out for collection without using paper bags. Please put items in separate piles to help prevent damage to our equipment. On April 23, 2018, we will return to the weekly pick up of paper bags for all yard waste.

### Large Item Pick up

We are eliminating the annual Village-wide Garbage pickup. As part of our contract with Republic Services, each service address is allowed 1 (one) large item pick up per week, throughout the year.

**This service is for Village of Quincy residents only & that are receiving garbage service through Republic.**

In order to have 1 large item pickup at your address, please contact the Village office by Thursday at 5:00 pm to have the item picked up the following Monday morning.

## Brush

The Department of Public Works will provide curbside pick up of brush the first Monday of each month beginning April 2, 2018, through December 3, 2018. Brush should be placed along the road no earlier than the Friday before the pick up starts. All brush must be beside the road by 7:00 a.m. on Monday. If a resident places brush out for pick up and the street has already been cleaned, the resident must remove the brush and hold it until the next pickup on the first Monday of the next month.

Brush must be no longer than 5 feet in length with all ends facing the same direction. The brush needs to be stacked neatly in piles and placed at the road side. Under no circumstances should the brush be placed in the roadway.

Storm damage will be collected as necessary. Other brush must be held until the next regularly scheduled pick up.



## Yard Waste (Weeds, Grass Clippings, Etc...)

Yard waste will be picked up in paper bags only each Monday, beginning April 23, 2018 and continue until bulk leaf pick up begins. Yard waste should be placed along the road no earlier than the Friday before the pickup starts. All yard waste must be beside the road by 7:00 a.m. on Monday. Bags are limited to 50 lbs. **Please do not deposit gravel, dirt, or sod in the bags.**

Paper bags may be purchased at local merchants.

## Leaves

In October and November, the Department of Public Works will provide bulk leaf pick up at the roadside (specific start date will be determined by the amount of leaves). All leaves are to be placed along the road, not on the road surface.

### DO NOT PUT ANYTHING IN THE PILE OF LEAVES.

The additional items will cause problems for the leaf vacuum and may result in your pile being left until the items are removed.
