



## REGULATING GOLF CART USAGE ON PUBLIC STREETS

- Drivers must possess a valid driver's license and be 16 years or older.
- Must not exceed 15 mph, and cannot operate a cart in a zone designated more than 30mph.
- Golf carts may not drive on US-12, except to cross at intersections.
- Cannot operate a golf cart from  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour before sunset and  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour after sunrise (daylight hours only).
- The operator must comply with the signal requirements of MCL 257.657a; MCL 257.648
- Must ride on the right side of the road.
- Golf carts shall not be operated on a sidewalk.
- A golf cart operated on the Village street is NOT required to be registered under this act for purposes of 3101 of the insurance code of 1956 (MCL 500.3101).
- The golf cart and drivers must be registered with the Village Clerk to be able to operate on a Village street.
- Operators must obey all traffic control (stop signs, stop lights, yield, right of way, proper overtaking of traffic, etc...)
