WHEREAS, the Village of Quincy periodically reviews its fees for zoning and planning services provided by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Quincy is participating in a joint effort to streamline the zoning and building permit process for residents in Bronson, Quincy, and Union City and fees need to be uniform for each community for this process.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Village Council orders the following rates and fees to be established effective March 24, 2020.

Child and Adult Care Facilities	\$200.00
Industrial Zoning Permit	\$200.00
Site Plan Review (Commercial, Industrial & Multiple Family)	\$250.00
Preliminary Plat Review	\$250.00
Final Plat Review	\$250.00
Special Use Permit Application (Excluding Child and Adult Care Facilities)	\$400.00
Rezoning/Conditional Zoning Application	\$500.00
Planned Unit Development Review	\$500.00
Site Condominium Development Review	\$500.00
Variance Application (Zoning Board of Appeals Review)	\$500.00
